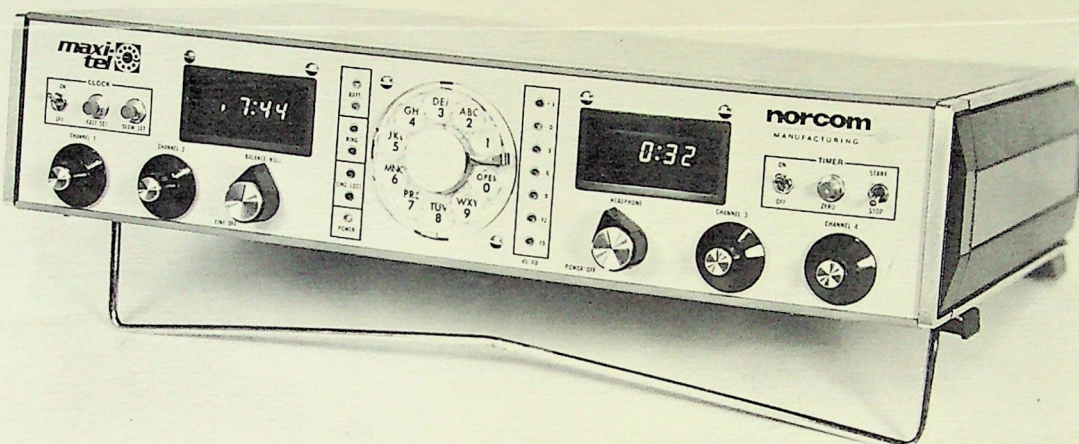

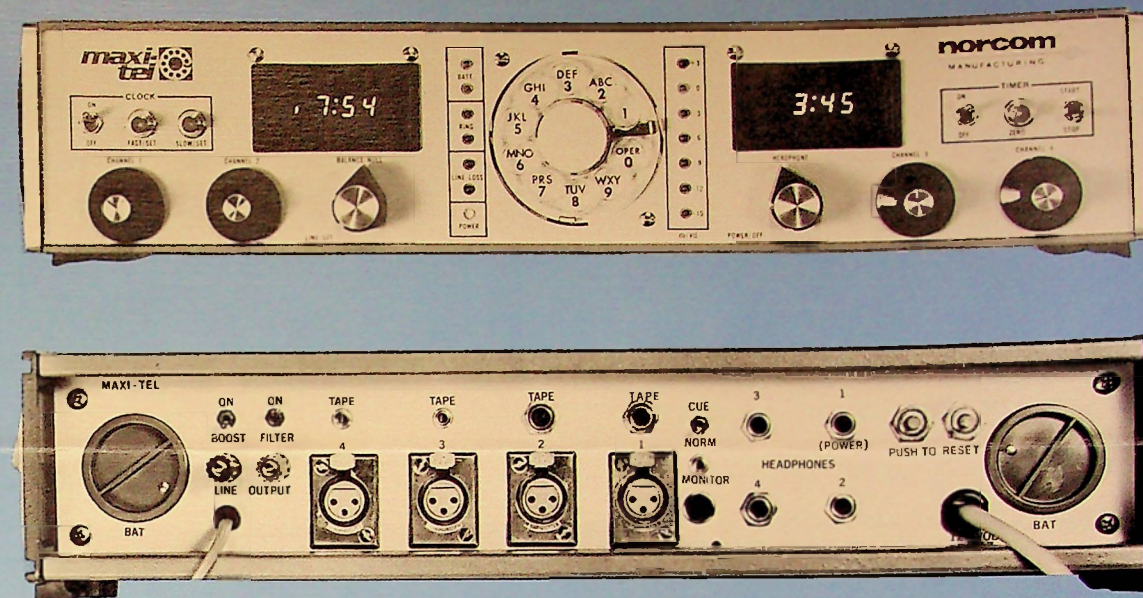
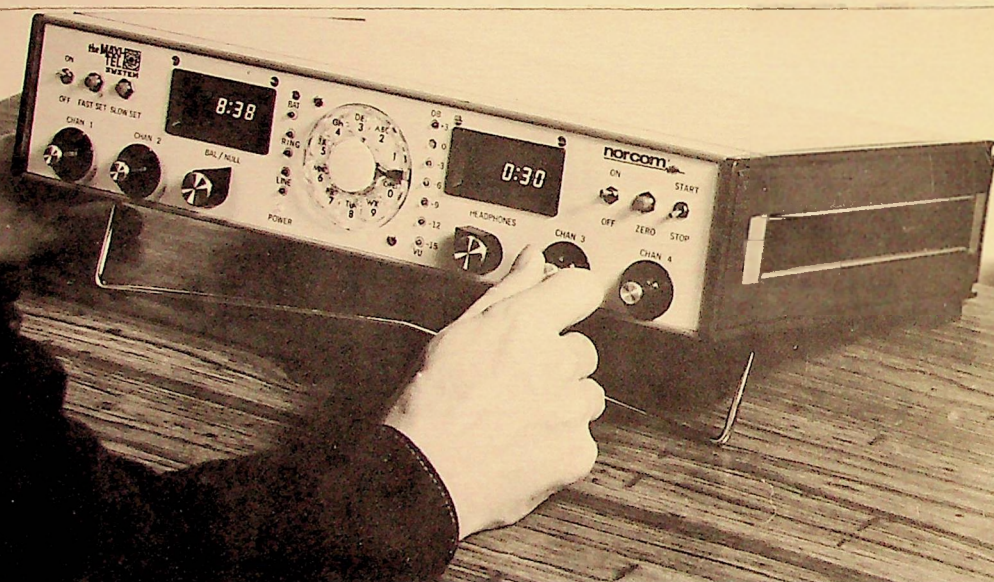

Utilizing the latest "state of the art" electronic design, the MAXI-TEL is your answer to all of your remote broadcast problems when using telephone lines. When you are at sports games, grand openings, conventions, or whatever. The "MAXI-TEL" will serve you flawlessly with exceptional broadcast quality. 120 volt operation plus up to 40 hours of battery back-up with alkaline "D" cell batteries makes the MAXI-TEL one of your most reliable pieces of broadcast equipment that you own.

- High intensity fluorescent digital time of day clock.
- High intensity fluorescent digital timer, minutes/seconds. (Clock and timer can be read in direct sunlight or darkness.)
- Pulse loss of line indicator.
- Pulse visual/aural ring system.
- Automatic pulse low battery indicator. (Warns you when 3 hours of battery life remains.)
- Ladder logarithmic VU indicator, from minus 15 to plus 3 dbm, 7 step.
- 4 mike/line channels with no switching required. (Will accept cart or cassette tape inputs.)
- Failsafe power circuit prevents batteries from being drained unintentionally. (System automatically merges to batteries when 120 volt power fails.)
- Long telephone line equalization selector. (Boosts low and high frequencies to maintain proper spectral/balance and intelligibility.)
- Switchable ultra sharp notch filter, tuned to 2.6 KHz. (To prevent spurious crowd noise from disconnecting phone line.)

When ordered with a MAXI-TEL system, they will be matched to the system for maximum performance ... at no extra charge.

SPECIFICATIONS

INPUTS: MICROPHONES: Four; Channel 4 is selectable to program buss or headphone amplifier.

TAPE: Four; two miniature jacks (for cassette recorder/players) and two standard 1/4" phone jacks (for cart decks, R-R tape transports, PA input, etc.) Channel 4 input is selectable to program buss or headphone amplifier for cueing.

EXTERNAL MONITOR: One miniature jack for input of off air monitor radio.

OUTPUTS: PROGRAM: Balanced, hybrid transformer for direct connection to standard telephone line or leased line. Modular cord with 4 prong adapter furnished, plus two 5-way binding posts for connection to hard line.

HEADPHONE: Four; will drive any impedance from 4 ohms and up. (A full watt of headphone power available to overcome crowd noises.)

RECORD OUTPUT: Standard miniature jack, low impedance mike level output.

OUTPUT LEVELS: Factory adjusted for -10 dbm. (Field adjustable to plus 17 dbm before clipping.) ie. Output can be set for plus 4 dbm with 13 db of headroom.

POWER REQUIREMENTS: Eight standard "D" cell alkaline batteries are used for up to forty hours of emergency back-up in case of failure of 120V line power.

Clock: Display On/Off, Set hours, Set minutes
